

1 **Will of Edmund Pawling, keeleman 12 August 1579**

2 My soul to Almighty God the Father and unto my Saviour and onely redeemer  
3 Jesus Christ, through whole death and merritts I believe faithfully that I am  
4 redeemed and saved and shall live with him for ever.

5 My body to be buried in the church porch of St Audrey

6 To Francis my wife all that my messuage and tenement with their apps. in the said  
7 parish of St. Audrey which I lately purchased of one John Tompson to her and her  
8 heirs for ever

9 To John Pawling my son all those my tenements with apts in the said parish of St. A.  
10 which I lately purchased of Lawrence Wood scryvener — when he reaches 18 years  
11 to him his heirs for ever.

12 the same John Pawling £30 to be paid at 18 years

13 To Mary Pawling my daughter £20 at 18 years

14 To Elizabeth Pawling my daughter £25 at 18 years

15 To Ann Pawling and Katherine Pawling my daughters £15 each at 18 years

16 If any of them die. before 18 their share to be divided equally amongst the others

17 To Frances my wife all my goods chattels, plate, implements and stuff of household  
18 whatsoever, so that she pay my debts and perform this my testament and last will.

19 Executrix — Frances Pawling

20 Supervisor — John Stingate — to receive 40/— for his pains

21 Witnesses — John Cooper, Richard Nixon, Thomas Scarlett, John Hocknell
