In the name of god amen The xix doy of August in the yere of ou(r) lord god I Isabell cob of norwiche widow in my good mynd at norwiche make my testament & last will in this wise

ffirst I comend my soul to Allmighty god ou(r) lady seynt mary & to all the hooly seymts in hevyn & my body to be beryed in the p(ar)oche of Seynt peter of Southgate in Norwiche To the wiche hey Aulter I bequethe iijs iiijd

It(e)m I woll have an honest prest to sing & pray for my Soule & my frends souls in the seid Church of Seymt peter by the space of an hoole yere
