

NYCHOLAS LYNNE'S WILL 1548

In the name of god AMEN in the yeare of our Lorde god MCCCCC xviii (1548) and the iiii daye of June and in the Second yeare of the Reigne of our soveraigne Lorde Edwarde the sext by the grace of god Kinge of Englonnde Ffrance and Irelande Defendor of the fayth and in ert h supreme hede of the church of England

I Nyeholas Lynne being in hole and gad (sic) myned and Remembrance laude be to god make my testament and last wyll in that maner and forme folowinge

for the first parte I bequeth my sowle to allmightie god and our blyssed Lady Saint Mary and to all the blyssed cumpany of hevin and my body to be buryed in the church yarde of Saynt Julyans in Norwich

I give and bequeth to John Barret my Servant my house lying in the parish of Saynt Julyane afferesaid ant (sic) he for to bere out the payments that ys for to paye.

And I give to John Barrett my Servant all my householed Stuff both movables and unmovables and he for to bringe me honestlye to the grownde and he for to take my Debts and to paye my Debts

And to make John Barret my Executor and none but he And I pray him to do for me as I wolde do for him yf he were in lyke case

Thes be the wytnes of this my Testament and last wyll John Jamys Jamys Lynne Richarde Albon Amma Cawston Robert John Hunt Anas John Marsham John Marshall and others.
