

WILL OF THOMAS ATMERE 1526

In the name of God Amen the 22nd daie of august in the yere of our lord god the 1526.

5 I, Thomas Atmere, whole of mynde and of good Remembrance make my will and teastament of this maner folowing First I bequeathe my soule to god allmightie, our lady, saynt marye, and all the saint in hevin, and my body to be buried in the churche
10 yarde of saint peter parmentergate in Norwiche. I bequethe to the highe altare of the said churche for tythes negligently forgotten 3s 4p.

15 Item I bequethe to the said churche 5s. I bequethe to the cathedrall church of Norwiche 12p. I bequethe to the Sepulchre light in Saynt peter churche of permantergate 12p.

20 Item I bequethe to our lady's light in the said churche 12p.

Item I bequethe to the 4 orders of friers in the 4 howses 12p.

I bequethe to the syster of Norman(s) in Norwich evry oon of them 4p.

25 I bequethe to the 4 howses of syke men evry house 6p.

I bequethe to John Barret 3s 4p. I bequethe William Barret and Philip Barret, the children of Jone Berret, to either of them when they come to lawful age 20d.

30 I bequethe to Harry, my sone, 3 pounds in money to be paied any quarter 6s 8p.

I bequethe to Johan my wife all the stuff of housold.

35 Allso I will have at my buriall daie one trentall said in the churche of saint peter for my sowle and my frends. Allso I wolle have oon prest to singe for my sowle and my
40 frends the space of halfe oon yere within the churche of saint peter parmentergate in Norwiche.

45 Allso I woll that John hazard gaine the said halfe yere to sing havyng to his stipend 4 marks 3s 4p.

Allso I woll that Johan my waief gain the house that I dwell in terme of her life and after her demise I wolle that it remayn to Harry my soon to free and geine. And allso I woll if so be Harry die afore Johan my wife then I woll that Jone my wife have the house to gene and to sell or to do not it what she woll.

The residew of my goods not gevin I bequethe them to Harry my soon and John my wife whom I make my executors for to paie my dette and fulfill my will and dispose the goods after your best mind for the healthe of my sowle and knightlie supvisor and he to have for his labour 3s 4p.
